American Society of Radiologic Technologists 2024 House of Delegates

The 2024 Commission met virtually on Feb. 5, 12, 20, 26 and March 7 and 25.

The Commission was assigned one main motion, which was received by the first business day of February. Main motions can be assigned to the Commission, ASRT Board of Directors or the Committee on Bylaws.

The Commission used an online survey tool for its work, which offered members the opportunity to provide feedback on the ASRT position statements and the Practice Standards Council motion **C-24.01** prior to making recommendations during the virtual meetings.

The Commission accomplished the goals as follows:

2/5/2024	Reviewed the 2023-2024 Practice Standards Council's proposed changes to the Table of Contents, Preface, Format, Definition, and Scope of Practice for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals.
2/12/2024	Reviewed revisions to standards 1-7 of the Practice Standards for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy.
2/20/2024	Reviewed revisions to standards 8-13, through the end of the document to include the Advisory Opinion Statements & Glossary of the Practice Standards for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy.
2/26/2024	Reviewed ASRT position statements.

On March 7, 2024, the Commission met virtually to finalize its recommendations on House motions **C-24.01** and **C-24.02**.

The Commission met again virtually on March 25, 2024, to make recommendations to the Board-referred motion **C-24.03**.

Rationale:

In keeping with its charges, the 2023-2024 Practice Standards Council, addressed the ASRT Practice Standards for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals for practice trends, emerging technology, language, and format consistency, as well as those items that had been held over for future review. The subcommittees scheduled for this review cycle included Bone Densitometry, Mammography, Radiation Therapy, and Sonography. Collectively the PSC and the above-mentioned subcommittees have provided recommendations for consideration. The proposed revisions can be reviewed in the following sections of **The ASRT Practice Standards for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy:** Table of Contents, Preface, Format, Definition, Scope of Practice, Standards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 and 13, Advisory Opinion Statements and Glossary.

Conforming Amendments:

Within this motion, there is a conforming amendment regarding the statement in Standard Five, *Radiation Therapy*. The conforming amendments are to be observed. The proposed changes would result in the striking of the glossary term fiducial markers.

Federal Minimum Standards for Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy statement has been amended to reflect professional inclusion by striking the word radiation before the word therapy. Currently, <i>therapy</i> is delivered by an increasing number of modalities within the medical imaging profession. 				
The amended statement will read as: It is the position of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists that the U.S. Congress should enact federal minimum standards of education and certification for all individuals performing, planning or delivering therapy or medical imaging.
